Lanvos Dr

Broad Gully Rd

- A** NEW CONCRETE PATH
1.8m Concrete path along edge of park.
- B** NEW FENCE
Timber post & rail fence running the entire length from top corner of Lanvos Drive & along Broad Gully Rd
- C** FORMAL GRAVEL TRACK
Gravel track around upper edge, meandering through a re-vegetated area with various benches and links to key play features. Heights of planting to vary with visual permeability & links to lowest corner of Broad Gully Rd
- D** OPEN SPACE
Existing open space is retained
- E** NEW SHELTERS
Large picnic shelter with BBQ & tables
Smaller shelter east of playspace with benches for informal hang out.

- F** EXISTING SHELTER
Cleaned and made good with new slab base & new BBQ, side tap & solar lighting
- G** TOILET BLOCK
New toilets centrally located with drinking fountains, two ambulant cubicles & 1 all-access cubicle.
- H** RETAINED BASKETBALL HOOP
- I** NEW EXERCISE AREA
Multi-function exercise equipment on rubber base.
- J** RETAINED BASKET SWING
With all access rubber path.
- K** SWINGS AREA
Triple bay swing including double swings with junior & adult seats, and one all-access swing seat with rubber impact area linked to path. All swings to have rubber directly underneath seats.
- L** TRAMPOLINE AREA
Twin set of small trampolines
- M** QUIETER / GATHERING SPACES / SENSORY PLAY
Large logs reclaimed from Gateway to Eltham works are used as links between path & large play area, with tops flattened slightly to limit slipping. Located away from houses are musical play nodes, along with sensory screens & touch benches.
- N** ALL-ACCESS CAROUSEL
With rubber base, linking to other accessible play areas.
- O** LARGE PLAY STRUCTURE
Play element with tower, multiple landings & platforms, slides at 900mm for juniors and 1800mm for older kids, balancing elements, nets & play areas underneath for imaginative play. Rock scramble slope and gravel paths link to bushland track.
- P** ROCK EDGING
Mudstone boulders at varied heights and widths as play edging & sitting
- Q** PICNIC TABLES
All access tables with concrete access path, in central picnic area with indigenous trees from local provenance to preserve integrity of bushland reserve.
- R** SEATING BENCHES
Various bench types, including:
 - Armrest on both sides
 - Armrest in middle with concrete pad
 - Wide benches near exercise areas for resting
 - Smaller benches for hanging out near play areas
- S** DRINKING FOUNTAIN
With bottle refill & dog bowl refill.
- T** RUBBISH BINS
- U** BIKE RACKS
With bicycle repair station
- V** PATH NETWORK
Concrete path designed as an all-access loop, main path is 1800 wide linking key areas & creating an island containing the main picnic area.
